

MAR DE ENVERO

The Winery

Mar de Envero is a winery that, since its founding in 2007, produces Galician white wines with Designation of Origin Rías Baixas. Manyo Moreira, enologist, after leading projects in different Spanish Denominations of Origin returns to Galicia, a land where he finds singular climate, soil and autochthonous grape varieties for the character and elegance he needs for his wines. Currently the winery offers two Albariño wines, Mar de Envero an unusual Galician wine elaborated and aged on its lees and Troupe, a shameless rogue white wine designed for enjoying in company.

The Name

As the wine maker was increasing his knowledge in viticulture in O Rosal, subarea of the larger section known as Rias Baixas (Lower Inlets) of the Galicia region in Northwestern Spain, he was amazed as he saw, on a specific area of vineyards in which the foliated surface of the vine arbor was below the road line, that this undulating foliage spread itself out, in a formation of green waves, towards the sea. He caught sight of this panorama in august, at the time when the grapes were beginning to change their color.

Envero

Phenomenon in the Growth Cycle that takes place in august, in which the grape turns sweeter and the grape's colour begins to turn yellow (white grapes) or red (rated grapes), thus providing the bunch the characteristic tone of maturation.
